

How to Enter a HOW Score in Power Teacher Pro


1. Log onto Power School and launch your gradebook.
2. Once in the gradebook, create a new assignment.
3. On the Create an assignment screen:


- a) Select which classes for the assignment to count for.
- b) enter a name for your assignment
- c) Select the HOW category
- d) Score type is automatically set to points. Make sure that score entry points is set to 4.
- e) Un-check the count in final grade box.

4. When this is set up, click on the standards tab.

5. On the standards check the box to select the HOW Standard only.




Then click on the "Show Selected Standards" Tab



6. Make sure that all the boxes are checked so the scores will automatically calculate for the standard.

Then click on the publish tab.

- Uncheck the publish scores box.
This keeps the assignment from being reported as a percentage score.



- Enter your scores for the assignment in the first column.

8. Enter your scores for the assignment in the first column.

In the second column, the program will auto calculate standard scores rounded to the nearest quarter of a point.
